New effects: Detailed inventory showing exact invoice amounts of new effects. Original invoice not older than 6 months with address at destination (not handwritten) Residence certificate or work permit from employer explaining that the employee obtained a new contract Transfer letter Copy of valid passport. For private clients only: taxpayer number "NIF" (of the private institution or individual) 	 For new effects, a tax of 35%-55% of the CIF value will be charged (for civilians and military clients). For new effects not older than 6 months: Name and address at destination Total invoice excluding VAT SIRET or SIREN numbers of supplier The supplier must state the exact origin of the goods on the invoice. 	 Not accepted by customs: Till slips Delivery notes Order forms Sales slips for export, intended for airport customs and not marine customs
Vehicles	 Valued, dated and signed inventory Original vehicle documents Passport copy of vehicle owner. New vehicle: Same as above New without VAT and registration plate: 	 All vehicles are subject to Customs duties if shipment not diplomatic. All vehicles not older than 15 years can be imported but a tax of 58% of the CIF value will apply.
